

STALLHOLDERS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Q.	A.
What is the cost of a stall?	£55.00
Where is the Market Stall area?	Barleybank Car Park, Kirkintilloch,
What is the size of the Stall?	8ft by 6ft covered stall
How many stalls can I request?	A maximum of two stalls is permitted per applicant
Is Public Liability Insurance essential?	Yes, no application will proceed without current year PLI
What if my Public Liability expires after application?	We will accept your application with current Public Liability Insurance but MUST be renewed to reflect the date of trading
What is the closing date for applications?	2 nd August 2024
When is Payment required?	14 days after being notified that you are successful in reserving a stall and payment is non-refundable
What are the operating hours?	Sunday 1 st September 12noon until 5.00p.m.
When can I access site to set up?	Stallholders require to have stalls set up by 10.30a.m. (access from 8.30a.m.) then all vehicles removed from site.
Is there a power supply?	NO
Is there car parking available close to the market area?	There is permitted use of car parks in close proximity. A site plan will be issued to you should your application be successful
Can I bring Tables, Chairs and additional equipment?	Small chairs are permitted but additional equipment must be kept to a minimum
Can I sell alcohol?	NO, alcohol will not be permitted for sale
Is there toilet provision	Portable Toilets are available on site
Why is a Food Safety Checklist and attachments needed	This is to assist the authority assess the food and safety procedures to protect public health.
Will I need an electrical safety certificate for new installations or equipment?	Timescales are not prescriptive in law but the HSE provide recommendations for operators, https://www.hse.gov.uk/pubns/books/hsg107.htm
What is a mobile food trader Certificate of Compliance?	You will need a street trading Certificate of Compliance for food safety when applying for a Street Trader's Licence. The council where your vehicle is garaged can provide this after inspection, https://www.eastdunbarton.gov.uk/residents/business/business-regulation/environmental-health
Who is arranging litter and refuse collection and street cleaning?	The Council's Streetscene Team will be working to remove waste refuse and maintain the festival site.

Please note: Road Closures will be in place on both days.
